**From 13th-22<sup>nd</sup> July 2012, there will be a No Border Camp in Cologne, Germany!**

**After a few organisational meetings, which took place mostly on regional level, we will now start the first round of germanwide-international meetings!**

They will take place approx. monthly in different cities. Here we want to talk and discuss about the tenor and choreography of the camp.

It would be good building up workinggroups (germanwide-international) about different topics so that duties and responsibilities should be shared amongst us.

It would be great, if many groups would come together, if many feel invited and join the process of organising and forming the camp.

It should not be a „white“ organised camp and it should kept in mind, that antiracism concerns all political parts, this means, that different political themes and groups will be involved.

Come and be part of it, bring in your ideas.

#### **The main topics for the camp, are at the moment:**

- massdeportation/charterdeportation of Roma people from airport Düsseldorf
- massdeportation/charterdeportation to Nigeria (EU-wide FRONTEX deportations)
- antiziganism in germany and europe
- racism in the society, allday racism, antimuslimic racism, debate about Sarrazin (racist german politician), the new right movement in europe
- living conditions of refugees and the fight of the migrants against it (fight against „lager“, institutional racism)
- strikes of migrants (e.g. at the airport)
- reasons of migration, land grabbing, colonialism

In Berlin we want to deal with these and maybe more themes and try to find a „bracket“, a motto which brings these different topics together. We want to see, which groups would like to contribute to these themes.

But we will also have to talk about technical details, as creating of workinggroups, mobilising, translation and many more.

It would be great to see you there! Please give a short note, if and with how many people you are coming, that helps us to plan the meeting.
